Course Outline

This course will focus first on basic principles of contract law, so you will better understand contracts and changes. Next, we'll address the most important provisions of the form contracts used by owners and contractors with an eye toward identifying those provisions which you should negotiate, and what language changes you should seek. We will discuss provisions regarding payment, delay, and indemnity, "consequential damages" and termination. We will also discuss the steps you can take to protect your company in the event of delay, acceleration and differing site conditions. We will focus on both the AIA and ConsensusDOCs form contracts, but we encourage you to bring along your own forms, other forms you've encountered and your questions. We will emphasize sub-contractor contracts.
